





- Playground supervision number of EA's (ratio adults to kids): 146 students, 9 recess supervisors (1:16), 8 lunch supervisors (1:18)
- 2. **Snack times/lunch times** snack at discretion of teacher, lunch recess at 12:20, lunch eating 12:50. Soft start at beginning of day and frequent snack breaks
